#### Required elements of successful applications for Mini Funds:

- described project uses NASA's Universe of Learning Resources to reach audiences via a program, event, exhibit, planetarium show, or other learning experience. (May use other resources as well)
- project can be documented as a model that is transferable to other organizations
- proposing organization has staff that have participated in UoL webinars/Community of Practice

#### The following are preferred characteristics of proposed projects:

- project broadens participation/ reaches targeted audiences underserved by STEM opportunities such as girls, underrepresented minorities, people with disabilities, rural audiences, etc
- the project draws on strengths of home institution e.g. multidisciplinary expertise, in-house resources, experiences with targeted audiences, etc

#### **Guidelines:**

- Audience size: Short-duration programs should engage larger numbers, programs reaching smaller numbers should emphasize a deeper connection, multi-session experience, etc.
- Other selection factors will include: geographic distribution; institutional diversity; programmatic variety
